PROSPECTUS

INTRODUCTION

Saint Claret School at Debpur was established in the year 2000 by the Claretian Society, registered under the West Bengal Societies Registration Act - 1967. The school is ICSE-affiliated (Class X) to Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations, New Delhi (Code. WB305). It is a co-educational school with English as the medium of instruction. A standard of English is a must for success in examinations. Therefore, only English is the campus language while due importance is also given to Bengali and Hindi in the curriculum. The school is administered by the code of regulations for the Anglo-Indian Schools in West Bengal.

SAINT ANTHONY MARIA CLARET

Saint Anthony Maria Claret, the Founder of Claretian Congregation, was born in Salient, Spain, on 23rd December 1807. He was brought up in a devotedly religious family and thus developed a deep devotion to Mother Mary. He, along with other five like-minded priests, founded the Congregation of the Missionaries Sons of the Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary (Claretian Missionaries) on 16th July 1849. He lived as an inspiring child, artistic youth, industrious textile industrialist, itinerant preacher, caring physician, merciful father, lover of the poor, humble missionary, unassuming Archbishop and thus a man on fire with God's love. He reached the heavenly abode on 24th October 1870, which is celebrated as his Feast Day.

The Flame reminds us that we are called to shine forth with knowledge and Love against ignorance and hatred.

ADMISSIONS AND WITHDRAWALS

1. New admissions are made to Nursery and other admissions, if any, will depend on availability of seats.
2. At the time of admission the parent/guardian must give the correct age of the child, producing the original Birth Certificate from the municipality. Catholic students must also produce a Baptism Certificate.
3. The candidates will have to appear for an admission interaction and will be examined at the standard immediately below that to which they seek admission.
4. The selection for admission shall be made entirely on the results of the interaction and on no other consideration. The school authorities reserve the sole right of refusing or granting admission. The admission process is completed only when the candidate has paid the required fees as per the fee schedule.
5. New students must be introduced personally by their parent/ guardian who will also be interviewed and are expected to co-operate with the school authority in helping the child's progress.
6. Pupils coming from a recognized school are required to bring a Transfer Certificate from the last school they attended, countersigned by the inspector of schools and the mark sheets of the last two years' annual examinations.
7. Before withdrawing a student from the school a month's notice is to be given or a month's fee in lieu of notice.
8. The transfer certificate will be issued only on the receipt of application from the Parents/Guardians, after a week of the submission of the completely filled-in application.

STUDIES

The school prepares the students for ICSE (Class X) and ISC (Class XII) examination of the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations, New Delhi.

The medium of instruction is English and importance is also given to Bengali and Hindi in the curriculum. A high standard of English is a must for the success in the exams. Therefore, only English should be spoken in the class rooms and the school premises by both the staff and students, on the violation of which strict disciplinary action will be taken. Parents should encourage their wards to speak in English.

EXAMINATION & PROMOTION

1. Promotion depends on the child's performance throughout the year in the tests: Unit Tests, Class Tests, Assignment and Terminal Examination. There are two Terminal Examinations in a scholastic year.
2. After each term, Progress Report Card will be issued.
3. For students who absent themselves from tests, no provision will be made for supplementary tests.
4. No children with any illness should be sent to school for the sake of exam.
5. The decision of the promotion committee headed by the Principal is final and binding.
6. No pupil will be promoted if the attendance is below 90% in an year.

NURSERY & KINDERGARTEN

Our School marked another significant milestone by starting the Nursery and Kindergarten from the academic year 2010-2011. We always strive to impart quality education based on values to ensure overall development of the students, right from their initial stage. Our students are blessed with a beautiful park. Age Eligibility Nursery: 3 years 9 months and above as on 1st April Kindergarten: 4 years 9 months and above as on 1st April Class I: 5 years 9 months and above as on 1st April.

CO-CURRICULAR & EXTRA-CURRICULARS

Co-curricular Activities form an integral part of school as they help to develop self-confidence and self esteem of the students. Co-curricular activities reflect the diverse interest of the students and lead to all round development of them.

FEES

1. Tuition fee and other charges, as per the fee structure list, are to be paid on or before 15th of the first month of every quarter, through demand draft / online. The fee also can be paid on half-yearly or yearly basis - in advance.
2. The fee for the months of January, February and March must be paid together on or before the 15 of January.
3. The school fees cover twelve calendar months. No reduction of fee is made for holidays or broken periods. Pupils are liable to be charged full fees as long as their names are officially on the rolls.
4. The school reserves the right to increase the fees at any time of the year if any increment is considered necessary.
5. A late fee of Rs. 50/- per month will be levied on the failure to pay within the stipulated time.
